

State of Rhode-Island and Providence Plantations.

W H E R E A S at the Superior Court of Judicature, &c. held at Tiverton, on the last Monday of June, and at Newport on the third Monday of September last, pursuant to an act of the General Assembly of said State, intitled, "An Act for confiscating the estates of certain persons therein described," informations were filed against George Roome, merchant; Ackus Sisson, Esq; Isaac Lawton, merchant; Jahleel Brenton, gentleman; Peleg Brown, gentleman; Samuel Bours, merchant; Richard Beale, gentleman; all late of Newport, in the county of Newport; Thomas Hafzard, son of Jonathan, of North-Kingstown, in the county of King's County, all of said State; and Charles Ward Apthorp, of the State of New-York; and against the following lot of land, said to be the property of said George Roome, situate partly in Newport and partly in Middletown, containing six acres; bounded northerly by land of John Northup, southerly by land of Edward Simmons, easterly on Easton's pond, and westerly on a highway.

Also against a certain farm, or tract of land, situate in New-Shoreham, said to be the property of said Ackus Sisson, containing ninety-seven acres; bounded northerly on land of Abel Franklin, easterly on land of James Dodge, southerly partly by land of Rowland Robinson, and partly by land of Nathan Gardner, and westerly by sea or salt-water.
