the Motion of Thos^r. Fox Whom made Oath Decord^r to Law certifi-
cate is granted them for Obtaining Probate thereof in due form
Whereupon they with James Madison, Thos^r. Parson & James
Coleman their executors entered into Bond for the same in
the sum of Twenty Thousand pounds
