for the Weight of one Thousand two hundred and thirty six pounds of Grof. Hemp Welter d
Water rotted and James Rains his Overseer came into Court and made Oath that the Hemp
above mentioned was duly Weighted and made upon the Plantation of the^d Field in this County
Dry Bright and Clean and the^d Fields & Rains made Oath that they nor Neither of them nor
any Other Person for them had^{not} Received a Certificate Reward or Premium for the same
