

Upon the Attachment obtained by Thos Harry Taylor Esq. against the Estate of Robert Thompson the Sheriff having Executed the same on the hands of John Jones who appeared in Court & being sworn deposed he had on his hands of the Estate of the said Thompson Two pounds Eight Shillings Two pence where upon the said Thompson was solemnly called but failing to appear to reply thereto the Plaintiff made Oath to his Account for two pounds two Shillings & Eight pence Therefore it is Considered by the Court that the P. recover against the said Deft his Debt aforesaid of Two pounds two Shillings & Eight pence and his Costs by him on this behalf expended And it is Ordered that the said Jones pay the Money aforesaid in his hands to the said Taylor towards Satisfying this Judgment

Ordered That George Taylor Receive the Sum that, being by the last Assembly for this County, of the Collectors of the respective Counties where the same is due & that he sell the same for Money for the use of this County and Accts. for the same when required by the Court of the said County

John Underwood is Appointed overseer of the Road in the Room of Tho West and that he with the Gang that was under the said West clear and keep the said Road in Repair

Teenor a Negro Girl belonging to Charles Fushier is by the Court Adjudged to be Twelve years old

On the Petition of William Godding he is Allowed to keep Ordinary at his house in this County for one Year from this time giving Security where upon he with John Mallary & John Morgan his Sureties entered into and Acknowledged their Bond for his keeping the said Ordinary according to Law & it is Ordered the Clerk of this Court prepare a License for him accordingly

An Indenture of Bargain & Sale Between Lawrence Franklyn of the one Part and George Head of the other part & Memorandum of Deed and Seisin thereon Endorsed was Acknowledged by the said Lawrence & Ordered to be Recorded & Mary the wife of the said Lawrence personally appeared in Court & being first properly examined as the Law directs Voluntarily relinquished her Right of Dower on the Estate Entailed by the said Indenture
