Philemon Franklyn presented into Court a certificate for tak-
ing up a Runaway Negro Man Slave Named Sam belonging to
Rich Burkigton of this County & took the Oath by Law required
which is Ordered to be certified

John Williams presented into Court a certificate of Edward
Spencer due ^{debet} to him by Jos. Spencer Esq; of this Edward for
this Edward taking up a Runaway Negro Man Slave Named
Harry belonging to Henry Ailes of Culpeper County, which this
Williams declared he as constable recd. this Negro from the said
Edward to convey to his Master & this Joseph being unwell &
not able to come to Court the same is Ordered to be certified
