



Ordered that each Tithable Person in this County Pay the Collector Six pounds & a half of Tobacco being the County Levy for this Year 1752. & that the Collector pay the same to the several persons to whom the same is proportioned. & that the Collection be let to the Sheriff & that he give bond for the same in the Clks Office
