Upon the Attachment obtained by Johnny Scott against William Eastwood the Sheriff having recovered the same in the hands of Zachary Taylor who appeared in Court & made Oath that he had in his hands of the Debts of the said Eastwood six pounds & Cur^t money and no more where upon the said Eastwood was solemnly called but failing to appear to Replevy the same the Plaintiff proved his Deb^t for five pounds Eighteen Shillings. Therefore it is Considered by the Court that the Plaintiff against the said Deb^t his Deb^t aforesaid of Five pounds Eighteen Shillings and his Costs by him in this behalf expended & it is Ordered that the said Taylor pay the Money in his hands to the said Scott towards Satisfying this Judgment.
