About The Cover - Confederate Memorial Hall (Historic Bleak House)

This antebellum mansion of 15 spacious rooms and wide halls, stands among lovely trees and elaborately landscaped grounds. It was built by Robert Houston Armstrong, a lawyer, in 1858 shortly after his marriage to Louisa Franklin. Tradition says that slaves were brought from the Jefferson County estate of her father, Major L D Franklin, to bake the brick at the site, and to perform the laborious construction. The young couple named their stately home, "Bleak House", from Charles Dickens' then-currently-popular novel of that name.

The house remained in the Armstrong family until 1906 when it was sold to Mr. and Mrs. John Scriggs Brown who, in 1936 sold it to Mr. and Mrs. Roy N Lotspeich. Mrs. Lotspeich in turn sold it in May 1959 to Knoxville Chapter #89 of the United Daughters of the Confederacy for a Confederate Memorial Museum and Chapter House.

During the siege of Knoxville by the Confederates under General James Longstreet, Nov to Dec 1863 (when he withdrew his forces from the area) the Armstrong house was the headquarters of General Overstreet and his staff. A firsthand account of the occupation and fighting around her home was told in a letter written by Mrs. Louisa (Franklin) Armstrong and published in the Knoxville Journal and Tribune on 27 Sep 1898.

She told how Longstreet had cannons placed on the front lawn, surrounded the house with pickets and placed sharpshooters at the windows from which the enemy was plainly visible, especially from the tower windows. She said that the shot from one of the windows that fatally wounded General William P Sanders caused artillery fire to be directed toward the house. A 20 lb. shell that failed to explode tore out a large section of the brick work of the northeast front room. Windows were broken and nearly every wall had bullet marks and one sharpshooter was killed in the tower.

As mute evidence today that soldiers were killed or wounded in the tower are crude portraits of three unnamed Confederates drawn on one wall by an unknown soldier-artist who wrote under his pictures the line, "Men who were shot up here". These strikingly different faces are remarkably well preserved after almost 100 years. The tower closed and the entrance sealed for many years, has been reopened by the UDC, and a new stairway to it has been built.

Much as been done to restore the house and grounds to their former grandeur and elegance. It was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1984.

Adelia (Armstrong) Lutz (born Jefferson County; died 1931) daughter of Robert and Louise (Franklin) Armstrong (who came from the lowlands of Scotland) became one of the state's best-known landscape artists and its first woman professional artist, carving a reputation not only in Knoxville and East Tennessee but across the state.

Edward Franklin died in McMinn County, Tennessee (National Banner and Nashville Whig, Wednesday 7 Sep 1831)

Mrs. Elizabeth B Franklin, wife of Lawson D Franklin died in Jefferson County, Tennessee near the mouth of the Nolichucky. (Nashville Whig, Tuesday, 5 May 1846)

Isaac Franklin, Esq. of Sumner County, Tennessee died on the 27th on his plantation in Louisiana. (Nashville Whig, Thursday 7 May 1846)

James R Franklin, a native of Tennessee, died in New Orleans. (National Banner and Nashville Daily Advertiser, Tuesday, 24 Jun 1834)

John Franklin died near Gallatin, Tennessee, an old and respectable citizen of Sumner County, Tennessee. (National Banner and Nashville Daily Advertiser, Monday, 14 Jul 1834)

Walter Franklin, Esq., Clerk of the House of Representatives, died at Lancaster, Pennsylvania. (Daily Republican Banner, Monday, 8 Oct 1838)

Tennessee Mortality Schedules from 1850, 1860 and 1880

Each census year was the year ended June 1, so the deaths recorded on these schedules were those occurring in the 12 month period ended June 1 of 1850, 1860 and 1880.

Information not included that may be of interest to researchers is: for 1850 and 1860 # days ill and for 1880 how long a resident of the county, where the disease was contracted, name of attending physician, statement of attending physician. On all schedules there were places for remarks, some of which detailed on cause of death of specific persons on the schedules.

For 1880 entries, if deceased was born in Tennessee and their parents were also, place of birth of parents has been omitted. If place of birth of parents was omitted by the enumerators, no mention of it is made on listing.

Arad Franklin and Nancy White

Arad Franklin (born 9 Dec 1802 New York; died 1897 Union County, Ohio) married 6 Mar 1825 Clark County, Ohio to Nancy White (born 1801 Bradford County, Pennsylvania) daughter of Joseph White. From the *History of Union County, Ohio*, Vol 2 published 1883 pp 421 and 422: "Arad removed with his father in Nov 1813 to Hamilton County, Ohio and eight years later to Clark County, Ohio. Here he married Nancy White and Oct 1826, packed his few household goods in a wagon and, with his wife and infant child, made his way to the Culwell Williamson land. He purchased fifty-seven acres north of Bokes Creek, paying \$2.50 per acre. He moved his family into the house of his father-in-law, Joseph White and returned to Clark County to harvest his corn crop. During the ensuing winter, he built his cabin, and moved into it in Feb 1827. Mr. Franklin has ever since been a resident of the township and though he is now 86 years old, is hale and hearty, and still active and busy with his farm duties".¹ Arad Franklin was a farmer, a Methodist and is recorded on the 1850 Scioto Twp, Delaware County, Ohio census; 1860 Leesbury Twp, Union County, Census; 1880 York Twp, Union County, Ohio Census (also listed in household is David W 13 year old male grandson. She was placed on his lap again and again jumped down and ran and told Grandma Jones that Grandpa Franklin was the devil. He was dark complexioned, had no teeth and snow white hair and Aunt Effie was frightened by him. Grandma Jones placed my mom in his arms and he was content to rock and cuddle his great-grand-daughter, Ivy Myrtle Jones. Aunt Effie lived to be 102 years of age.

Out 'n About With Elaine

I, along with several other researchers, recently attended a lecture sponsored by the Matagorda County Historical Society, Bay City, Texas. Lecture was presented by William Dollarhide. His lecture covered the use of deeds and other land records. Recommendation for two excellent reference books for understanding land records: Val D Greenwood, *The Researcher's Guide to American Genealogy*, (Genealogical Publishing Co.), 2nd Edition (1990); and William Thorndale, "Land and Tax Records", in *The Source: A Guidebook of American Genealogy*, (Ancestry, Inc., 1984).

According to Mr. Dollarhide, 90% of white, adult, male population owned land before 1850. This would, therefore, give you a 90% chance of finding your ancestor through land and/or deed records.

Land records are more complete and span a longer period of time than any other type of genealogical source and because of English Common Law - Dower rights of the wife - any transfer of property usually names the wife.

Some Terminology:

A Warrant: the public document which authorizes a tract of land to be set aside for a land grant or sale.

A Survey: the public document which indicates the physical bounds of a piece of property, either in a descriptive manner or in the form of a line drawing or map.

A Patent: the public document issued (by government or proprietor) indicating the first title/grant of a piece of property.

A Deed: the private document which records that the title to a piece of property was transferred from one party to another.

A Grantor: the party selling or relinquishing land.

A Grantee: the party buying, or being granted land.

Checklist for Deed Research

A county must be known first

Come prepared with census or tax lists to find the names if the neighbors.

Start with the Grantee/Grantor index.

Read every entry for every deed indexed, noting the first entry and last entry.

Write down every entry for the surname you want.

Look for "et al" (which is Latin for "and others" which may indicate a group of heirs.

Get a USGS (7.5 series) topographic map of the area, or see if County Engineer's office has detailed county maps available. (You will need a map that shows Range/Township lines). The USGS (7.5 series) Topographic map may be ordered at no cost by dialing 1-800-USA-MAPS. Ask for the Index to Map coverage by state. After you receive your Index to Map coverage by the states you ordered; you may then order the map for the county in which you are interested at \$2.50 each.

Look at Probate Index at the same time you are in the courthouse.

Look at Civil Court Index at same time you are in the courthouse.

If you are unable to go to the courthouse in the county you are researching, you can borrow LDS library microfilm for deeds (indexed and deed books) for about \$2.50 per roll. They will usually allow you to keep the film for up to 30 days.

Deed indexes many times make reference to a "case number" for some civil action regarding property. Civil cases are excellent sources of genealogical information - but poorly indexed. Therefore, going through deeds first may present the only clue that other records exist in another part of the courthouse.
