About the Cover

Mary Catherine Franklin was born 16 Jan 1844 Gallatin County, KY to William Thomas Franklin and Sarah (Benham) Franklin.

She most likely spent her formative years in Gallatin County which, at the time, was a sparsely populated rural farming area. According to the 1850 Federal Census, the family moved to Kenton Co., KY where she lived with her parents until she married.

Mary Catherine Franklin married Elisha Hudson Bird, Feb 1867 at the age of 23 years. Elisha, now 39 years old, was a widower having been married before to another Franklin, Mary Catherine's Aunt, Mary Messic Franklin. Mary Messic Franklin and Elisha Hudson Bird had eight children before she died 22 Aug 1866 in Kenton Co., KY. An infant son, Charles Sherman Bird died 19 days after the death of his mother.

Six months after his first wife died Elisha Hudson Bird married Mary Catherine Franklin. Probably Mary Catherine and Elisha Hudson were married in Kenton Co., KY. However, by the time of the 1870 Federal Census, they had moved to Trimble County, KY where they were to remain the rest of their married life.

Undoubtedly, from the very onset of her married life, she had her hands full with her new family. The oldest child was a 15 year old boy while the youngest child was a 3 year old girl. Between the oldest and youngest were five more to care for, whose ages were 13, 11, 9, 7 and 6 years - all boys.

By the 15 December 1867, Mary Catherine gave birth to her first child, Robert Seymour Bird. She would bear nine children of her own before her family was completed.

Elisha Hudson Bird was a farmer, owning his own farmland in Trimble County. He and Mary Catherine lived and worked the farm as did their neighbors, as Trimble County was an agrarian area. Later, about 1890, Elisha sold much of his property to his "older" children.

The photo of Mary Catherine with six of her children, was probably taken October of 1900 when Mary Catherine was 56 years old. There is a similar photograph taken at this time of Elisha Hudson Bird and his boys by Mary Messic Franklin Bird. Three of her children had died by 1900.

Elisha Hudson Bird died 18 November 1900 shortly after this photo was taken. Mary Catherine had to handle the remaining farmland by herself, most assuredly with the help of the older sons.

By 1908 Elisha Henry Bird had married Minnie Ann Thomas from southern Kentucky,

Mrs. Mary Catherine Bird, the daughter of Mr. & Mrs. Wm. Franklin, departed this life February 4, 1923. Born Gallatin County, Kentucky, January 16, 1844, she was reared in Kentucky and spent her entire life in Kentucky and Indiana. She was married in the month of February, 1867. To this union nine children were born. Three have preceded her to their future home. She was also bereaved of her husband in 1900.

Mrs. Bird became a Christian many years ago, uniting with the Methodist Church. In 1921 she transferred her membership to the North Side Na_____ Church and to this church and her God she was ever faithful until called to her reward, having completed her mission and finished the course. Mrs. Bird had been a sufferer from asthma for several years. This disease, with a stroke of apoplexy hastened her death.

Mrs. Bird was very much loved by those who knew her, and was held in the highest esteem in the church and was the oldest member in the church. She leaves to mourn her loss four sons Marton C., Thomas V., Henry E., of Indianapolis and Ira Walker of Denver, Colorado; two daughters Mary Bennett of Denver, Colorado and Minnie B. Hill of Indianapolis; also eight grandchildren and one great-grandchild, with a host of friends.

(Note by Virgil Henry Bird (1975) father of Henryette Altonia Bird Mahon writes: "She died in our house on W. 35th St., in Indianapolis, Indiana, having lived with us for sometime prior to the stroke. I was 9 years old and remember her quite well. She was deeply religious and very active for her age. Although Kentuckians, most of the Birds migrated to Indianapolis. Here, she spent her later years mostly with her children moving about them from time to time."

and moved to Indianapolis, Indiana. Mary Catherine, by now having no minor children, went to live with Elisha Henry and spent her remaining years in Indiana very active in Church work and, according to her obituaries, beloved by all.

Edward T. Franklin & Charlotte (Dean) Franklin

Edward T Franklin (born 11 Oct 1780 - died 20 Sept 1846 in Gallatin Co., KY.) He married 29 Jan 1818 in Falmouth, Pendleton Co, KY, to Charlotte Dean (b 28 July 1793 - died 12 Nov 1846 Gallatin Co., KY), daughter of James Dean, who was born 28 Jul 1793.

Their children:

1. William Thomas Franklin (born 2 May 1819 in Gallatin Co, KY died January 1901 probably in Covington, KY where he had lived for many years). William married (#1) 23 Dec 1840 in Gallatin Co, KY, BK 2, Sarah Benham, daughter of Jacob Benham. Sarah was born 20 Feb 1816 and died 10 Aug 1852 in Covington, KY. William married (#2) Gallatin Co., KY 11 Apr 1853, Margaret Ramey/Ramey who was born 20 Sep 1823. Margaret died 17 Feb 1889. There were no children from the second marriage. William & Sarah's children:
 - (1) James Edward Franklin (born 5 Mar 1842 in Gallatin Co, KY) married 27 Jul 1870, Julia A Bucksot who was born 12 Mar 1852. No children of this marriage in these records.
 - (2) Mary Catherine Franklin (born 16 Jan 1844 in Gallatin Co, KY - died 4 Feb 1923 Indianapolis, Marion Co., Indiana buried Crown Hill Cemetery) married Feb 1867 to Elisha Hudson Bird, as his second wife. Elisha Hudson Bird was born 27 Apr 1828 in Campbell Co, KY. - died 21 Nov 1900 in Milton, Trimble Co, KY and was buried in Monroe-Wise Cem, Trimble Co, KY. Elisha Hudson was also married to Mary Messic Franklin. Mary Catherine Franklin Bird & Elisha Hudson Bird's children were:
 - A. Robert Seymour Bird (b 15 Dec 1867 - d 20 July 1892 buried Monroe-Wise Cemetery, Trimble Co., KY).
 - B. Morton Colfax Bird (b 28 July 1869 - d 25 Oct 1939 Indianapolis, Indiana buried Crown Hill Cemetery) married Susan Kendall. No children.
 - C. Thomas Vernon Bird (b 12 Mar 1871 - d 31 Dec 1944 Indianapolis, IN buried Crown Hill Cemetery) married Pearl Dutton.
 - D. Mary Messic Bird (b 19 Jun 1873) married Charles Bennett; moved to Denver, Colorado.
 - E. Minnesota "Minnie" Bird (b 26 Aug 1875 - d 5 April 1954 Indianapolis, IN) married Turner Hill.
 - F. Oliver Roland Bird (b 10 Sept 1877 - d Sept 1880 buried Monroe-Wise Cemetery, Trimble Co., KY.)
 - G. Ollie Bessie Bird (b 10 Mar 1880 - d 29 Apr 1893 buried Monroe-Wise Cemetery, Trimble Co., KY.)
 - H. Elisha Henry Bird (b 5 Feb 1882 Trimble Co., KY - d 21 Nov 1969 Miami, FLA buried Woodlawn Park Cemetery, Dade Co., FL) married 1908 Minnie Ann Thompson (b 11 Jan 1881 Cave City, Barren Co., KY. - died 13 Nov 1943 Miami, Florida buried Woodlawn Park Cemetery.)
 - I. Ira Walker Bird (b 12 Aug 1884 Trimble Co., KY - d 12 Nov 1948). Ira never married.
- (3) Thomas A Franklin (b. 30 Sep 1845)

- (4) Benjamin Franklin (born 24 Oct 1850 in Kenton Co, KY died 6 Aug 1852 Covington, Kenton Co., KY).
2. Mary Messic Franklin (born 24 Jan 1830 in Gallatin Co, KY - died 22 Aug 1866 Covington, Kenton Co., KY) married 26 Mar 1851 in Kenton Co, KY, Elisha Hudson Bird, as his first wife, (born 27 Apr 1828 in Campbell Co, KY - died 21 Nov 1900 in Milton, Trimble Co, KY and was buried in Monroe-Wise Cem, Trimble Co, KY). Elisha Hudson was also married to Mary Catherine Franklin. Children to Elisha Hudson Bird and Mary Messic (Franklin) Bird are:
- (1) Edward Franklin Bird (b 9 Feb 1852 Kenton Co., KY - d 21 Oct 1900 Trimble Co., KY) married 27 Mar 1879 to Olive Mosser Trimble Co.,KY. Both are buried Mt. Carmel Cemetery, Trimble Co., KY.

- (3) Gustavus Adolphus Bird (b 23 Nov 1855 Kenton Co., KY - d 27 Mar 1937 Indianapolis, Indiana) married 4 Feb 1880 to Sarah Whaley in Trimble Co., KY.
- (4) George William Bird (born 4 Jun 1858 in Kenton Co, KY. d 13 Feb 1942 Trimble Co., KY buried Mt. Carmel Cemetery, Trimble Co., KY) married #1 in 1883 to Ida Mosser (born 3 Aug 1864 in Allegheny Co, PA). George William Bird married #2 Margie Ellen Rand on 24 Nov 1904 in Madison, Jefferson Co., Indiana. George & Ida's Children:
- A. Oscar William Bird, son of George William and Ida (Mosser) Bird, was born 24 Nov 1887 in Milton, Trimble Co, KY, and married 6 Mar 1916 in Milton, Trimble Co, KY, Nadine Gallagher who was born 6 Mar 1896 in Madison, IN. Oscar William died 16 Mar 1968 in Madison, IN. Nadine died 21 Feb 1926 in Milton, Trimble Co, KY. Their Children:
- (A) Mildred Bird, daughter of Oscar William and Nadine (Gallagher) Bird, was born 8 Apr 1919 in Milton, Trimble Co, KY, and married 16 Nov 1942 in Long Beach, CA, Wilfred T Ridgway.
- (5) John Monroe Bird (b 23 July 1860 Kenton Co., KY - d 25 Dec 1912 Trimble Co., KY buried Mt. Carmel Cemetery, Trimble Co., KY) married #1 Emma Meek on 23 May 1889; #2 to Mabel Holsclaw 25 Feb 1896.
- (6) James Dora Bird (b 17 Dec 1861 Kenton Co., KY - d 10 Nov 1942 Jefferson Co., Indiana) married 2 Jan 1891 to Lou Ella Kendall.
- (7) Juniata "Junie" Bird (b 17 Mar 1864 Kenton Co., KY - d 21 July 1943 in Colorado) married 24 Feb 1885 to Paul L. Heim in Trimble Co., KY.
- (8) Charles Sherman Bird (b 4 Mar 1866 Kenton Co., KY - d 10 Sept 1866 Kenton Co., KY).

History of the Orphan Brigade

William W. Franklin, Barren County, KY was transferred from Co. F, April 26, 1862. Was appointed corporal, 1862, and promoted to sergeant, 1863. Fought at Vicksburg, Baton Rouge, Stone River, Chickamauga, Rocky Face Ridge, Resaca, and Dallas; was wounded and permanently disabled at the latter place, and was afterward retired.

At the age of 103 she bowled 200. She stands a petite, but erect 5 ft and weighs about 130 lbs with her 8 pound lady's bowling ball.

Her daughter - Vivian Kearney says "Essie is very independent and doesn't like people to hold her arm..." she says, "suppose they fell and took me with them".

She celebrated her 108 birthday with a party, visits from her family and best wishes from the governor of Missouri. Willard Scott of "The Today Show" mentioned her bowling record and sent his birthday wishes on national TV.

Ester died Sunday, 8 Oct 1995 at the National HealthCare Center of Maryland Heights. She was survived by two granddaughters and three great-grandsons.

Abel Franklin

(New England Historical and Genealogical Register, Vol. 105, pp 254-256, "Notes on Eighteenth Century Block Island").

Abel Franklin was a prominent inhabitant of Jamestown. He was the first keeper of the Beavertail Light and owned the North and South ferries on the west side of Connecticut Island, which ran to South County.

He was frequently a member of the Jamestown Town Council. In 1731 he purchased land at the Island (New Shoreham Deeds, Book 3 pg. 70).

He married Sarah Remington daughter of Stephen and Penelope Remington, who is buried in the Franklin Burying Lot in South Kingston. She died 10 Dec 1778 in her 91st year. Her husband is buried in Jamestown. He died testate in 1758, "aged 68 years".

Abel Franklin is apparently the Abel Franklin, who was born at Dartmouth, Mass. 18 May 1690, the son of James Franklin who was a townsman at Dartmouth in 1686². James had been a soldier in Phillip's War. On 24 Aug 1676 he had served under Capt. Daniel Henschman³. On 24 Aug 1676 he was in Capt. Thomas Brattle's Company⁴. On 9 Dec 1675 he was one of Capt. Samuel Moseley's volunteer troopers and was present at the Great Swamp Fright later in that month⁵. On 24 Aug 1676 his pay was assigned at Braintree, Mass. This would indicate that at that date he was probably a resident of that town⁶. He was evidently a young man at the time of the war. James was living in Rhode Island in October 1693, when he bought land in Dartmouth. In 1706 he was of Swansea. In 1710 he was styled "Cordwainer" and was "of Rehoboth", but by 1716 he had returned to Swansea. His wife was named Elizabeth⁷ [See FFRU Vol 11, pg 60] His son James Franklin, Jr. removed from Swansea to Scituate, Rhode Island where he died testate on 21 Oct 1756. It seems probable that the elder James Franklin was a brother of John Franklin of Swansea, cordwainer, who with his wife Ruth, sold land there in 1717, and James Franklin was a witness⁸. (Source: "Short History of the West Ferries of Jamestown", by Susan Braley Franklin, Ph.D., Bull. Jamestown Hist. Soc., June 1941; information supplied by Susan Braley Franklin.) Stacy and Winifred (Wood) Franklin

The following was submitted by Dan Nelson, 14686 Hiddenspring Circle, Chino Hills, CA 91709 (1993). Extracts from a letter received July 28, 1931, from Mrs. Byfield Walker (Sarah Elmira Le-phiew, granddaughter of Ethelbert Sexton Franklin, and great-granddaughter of Thomas Baker Franklin. See "The Andrea Papers".

"My great-grandfather, whose name I believe was Stacy and his wife, Winifred Wood, came from Carolina in an ox wagon; they came to Farmerville[sic], Louisiana, for a short period and then to Bradley County in Arkansas, settling on a creek and they called it Franklin Creek to this day - 2 1/2 miles from Warren.

Great grandfather Franklin had five sons and one daughter by his wife Winifred Wood. As I recall their names were Ethelbert Sexton, Alfred, William., Thomas., Ike and the daughter's name Winifred Wood. There were two sons by a second marriage Benjamin and Washington.

When Grand Pa was 12 years old (that would be in 1817, as he was born in 1805 according to 1850 census of Bradley Co., Arkansas, J.H.P.) they came to Arkansas and that was a long time ago. The logs of that first house were still standing when I was there. Dr. Cabeen, Aunt Winifred's husband, came from the same place in Carolina, also Hamptons and Meeks. Of course, you know the place. The Franklins were English Welsh. It is in the past, when I read in the Gazette I think it was concerning those who came over on Mayflower, and they gave the name of J. C. Franklin. If I could go to Warren, maybe I could get some information from courthouse. I don't think the Martins knew their mother was a Franklin. Dr. Martin got his best help from Franklins.

He gave the children of Thomas (he didn't know the middle name) Franklin and Winifred Wood as: Thomas, Ethelbert Sexton, Jefferson, Winifred Alfred S. By the second marriage: John Washington, Isaac, Benjamin and a daughter, whose name he did not know. There was an Ann Franklin who married Richard Miller in Union Co., Arkansas on 3 Jan 1839. She could have been a late child of a second marriage.

ren, Arkansas.

Her gravestone as copied on Aug. 10, 1941, reads as follows:

Winefred W. Cabeen

Feb. 8 1853 - age 65

This would make the date of her birth either 1787 or 1788, depending on whether she was 65 or in her 65th year and also what time of the year her birth occurred.

The census of 1850, Bradley Co., Arkansas, gives the following:

John T. Cabeen, 60 farmer, born in SC,- wife, Winifred, 58, born in SC. Living in household were Samuel Meek, 23, born in Ala., Mira E. Meek, 23, born in Ark.; Ellen Franklin, 21, born in Ark.; Sarah Franklin, 26 born in Arkansas. (I believe Ellen and

The above census would seem to make her born in 1792 in SC and she could have been older than her husband and did not want either her husband or the enumerator to know her age.

I believe it is best to take the record as it is. That Thomas Baker Franklin's wife (his first wife) was Ann _____. That she was the mother of Winifred Wood Franklin, Alfred Stacy Franklin, Etherbert Sexton Franklin, Thomas and possibly others. Thomas Baker Franklin married a second time and had several children. It is certain that Ann was wife when Alfred Stacy Franklin and Etherbert Sexton Franklin were born - 1802 and 1805 respectively. I am positive that Ann, whether she was also named Winifred or not, was a Wood. It will be best not to bring up the Winifred as a second name as it only puts an air of doubt on the findings.

You will note that there were two Winifred Woods in descendants. Also one son of Thomas

Baker Franklin had a Nancy Wood and another had a William Wood. One had an Elizabeth Ann Franklin and a Frances Emily Franklin; the other had an Ann Franklin, a Thomas Baxter (or Baker) Franklin, and a John Edwin Franklin., he also had a Mary Elizabeth Franklin.

The Bradley County settlement was mainly a settlement of former residents of Chester County, SC. The gravestone in Franklin family burying ground near Warren, Arkansas, has a grave of Thomas Baker Franklin and he is shown as aged 64 years. His estate was admitted to probate in late summer, 1829, which would make him born in 1765. There were only two Thomas Baker Franklin's in SC in 1790; the other man was single according to deeds, therefore, the son of Thomas Franklin and Priscilla is bound to be, positively, in my opinion the man who died in Bradley Co., Ark. The only uncertainty is the Winifred Wood as his wife. Now we know from records that she was named Ann and from the deed from William and Sarah Wood the probability is she was their daughter. The Winifred Wood being the wife of Thomas Baker Franklin confuses the matter, but it should not. Like Woodrow Wilson she had two Christian names and used only one, or she was Ann (Wood?) and named her child Winifred Wood Franklin, possibly for her mother. In this case the descendants of Elizabeth Ann Franklin got the name of her daughter, Winifred Wood Franklin married Cabeen confused with Ann's name. I think records should govern you: Ann was her name and then there is no uncertainty as far as I see it.
