It is NOT a Soundex, which only included families that had children over the age of 10, and again, unlike the Soundex, this is not just indexed by head of household, rather every name can be searched.

Book Review: *Ancestors and descendants of Josiah Garland and Miriam Moore, early settlers at Union River, Hancock County, Maine*

My Observations: The work is well laid out in Register format, including photos and a detailed bibliography. Many sources are cited. There is a list of abbreviations in the front of the book, but many non-standard abbreviations are used and are not listed. In addition, place names are shortened, counties and states omitted, so it is difficult to understand where the various events took place. I've done my best to correct this below.

Earliest Franklin Progenitor: In 1844, Benjamin Franklin Garland changed his name to Benjamin Franklin, apparently to avoid confusion, because there were other family members by the same name. When he changed his name, he already had children, all of whom also changed their surnames to Franklin. He was born in 1797 (son of Edward Garland) probably at or near Sunhaze (now Milford), Penobscot County, Maine.¹

He married Miriam Townsend about 1827. She was born 26 Jan 1808 at Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, the daughter of Gera Townsend and Betsey Garland. She died 26 Jan 1901 "on her 93rd birthday". She is buried in Greenwood Cemetery. Benjamin and Miriam were first cousins.

Children of Benjamin and Miriam (Townsend) Franklin:

- I. Elvira Franklin born about 1828; died 21 Oct 1832, age 4 years.
- II. Ziba Franklin born about 1830; living 1870 Census; unmarried.
- III. Laban Loring Franklin was born 2 Sep 1832 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine.²
About 1858 he married 1) Lucretia L. Smith who was born about 1841 probably in Mariaville, the daughter of Joseph T. Smith and Emma H. Moore. She died 17 Jul 1864 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, age 23 years. She is buried in a small family plot on the east side of Route 180 about a half mile south of the Green Lake National Fish Hatchery, on land which originally belonged to Benjamin Franklin Garland above. Her two infant sons are buried near her.
About 1865, Laban married 2) Mary Jane Redman. She was born 26 Mar 1835/6 Brooksville, the daughter of Israel Redman and Sarah Rogers. She died 14 Sept 1914 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, age 79 years 5 months 18 days, buried Greenwood Cemetery.

Laban died of a concussion eight days after being thrown from his buggy when his horse was startled on Mill Street in Ellsworth Falls, on 10 Sep 1903 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, age 71 years. He is buried in Greenwood Cemetery, Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine.

Children of Laban Franklin and Lucretia (Smith) Franklin:

He married Mrs. Annie Lewis (Chatto) Getty on 24 Dec 1888 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine by Rev. Ephraim Harding. She was born 28 Sep 1867 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, the daughter of John Roundy Chatto and Castillia Lacoste Fullerton. On 18 Aug 1887 Mrs. Annie L. Getty received a final decree of divorce for desertion in 1884 from Robert Getty, whom she had married on 9 Nov 1881 at Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine. Her two Getty children, Elizabeth Frances Getty born 24 Mar 1883 and Llewellyn Barton Getty born 18 Jan 1885, later assumed the surname Franklin. Annie died on 7 Oct 1931 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, buried Juniper Cemetery, Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine.

Ernest L. Franklin worked in lumber mills most of his life and said that he started to work at the age of eleven. He was musically talented, had an excellent singing voice, played the cornet and at one time was a member of the Ellsworth Falls Town Band. From him came the story of his grandfather's changing his name from Garland to Franklin.

Ernest died on 17 Mar 1946 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, buried Juniper Cemetery, Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine.

He married Armenia Brown on 13 Jan 1892 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine. She was born 22 Feb 1873 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, the daughter of James H. Brown and Eunice Herrick Webber. She died 6 Sep 1962 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, buried Juniper Cemetery.

Like his father, brothers and uncles, Loring Franklin was associated with the lumber business most of his life. Loring died 26 Oct 1947 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, buried Juniper Cemetery, Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine.

Moore Frazier on 28 May 1913 at Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine. She was born 25 Mar 1867 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, the daughter of Jeremiah Moore and Hannah S. Frost. She died 1947, buried Greenwood Cemetery. She was married first to Emery O. Frazier on 28 Sep 1884 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, by whom she had two sons, Ivory M. Frazier born May 1886 and Vernal E. Frazier born Dec 1888 (1900 Census). Everett and Hattie had no children, but adopted Hattie's cousin, Donald D. Moore, who took the name Donald D. Franklin. The latter was a World War II veteran, buried Greenwood Cemetery.

Everett died 18 May 1960 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, buried Greenwood Cemetery, Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine.

IV. Edwin Franklin was born Nov 1835 Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine.³

He married Charlotte Ann McFarland on 3 Oct 1860 at Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine. She was born 25 Oct 1844 probably in Hancock, the daughter of Richard C. McFarland and Elizabeth Holmes.^{4,5} She died after her husband.

Edwin and Charlotte lived in Ellsworth until sometime before 1880 when they apparently moved to Biddeford, York County, Maine, because in the census of 1880 year they were in Biddeford. In 1886 Edwin was listed in the Biddeford Directory as a carpenter for the Pepperell Company. Edwin is listed as owner of a lot in Greenwood Cemetery, Ellsworth, Hancock County, Maine, which may be the burial place of his child, Nellie.

Edwin died 16 Jan 1901 Saco, York County, Maine, age 66 years 1 month 29 days, buried Greenwood Cemetery, Saco⁶.

He married Naomi Hayman on 1 Jan 1884 at Haverhill, Massachusetts. She was born Apr 1861 St. Stephens, New Bedford⁷, Massachusetts, the daughter of Jeremiah Hayman. Richard Franklin, a shoemaker, was living in Haverhill at the time of the 1900 census. He died 1 Dec 1917 Haverhill, Massachusetts.

Elizabeth died after 14 Apr 1942 when she made a deposition in Haverhill, Massachusetts.

Martin and Matilda Young, both born in New Bedford, Massachusetts. He died 12 Feb 1897 Saco, York County, Maine, of typhoid fever, age 29 years 5 months, buried Saco, York County, Maine.

Della was a widow with two sons in 1900, living in Saco, York County, Maine with her parents at the time of the census.

Following is a story of a man who gave his name as James Wilson Franklin, and who was identified by his brother who lives in Montgomery as the true James Wilson Franklin, and who died at the welfare home here in Andalusia and who was buried at Fairmount Church, Red Level, Monday, and, following the funeral who should turn up in Andalusia but the real James Wilson Franklin. Here is the story related by the Foreman Funeral Home's Manager: Several weeks ago a man came to Andalusia and gave his name as "Mr. Green". He was a sewing machine mechanic (he claimed), he was taken ill at Keys Boarding House and Mrs. Dell O'Neal Hart was called. She sent him to a local hospital where he stayed for several weeks. Mrs. Hart later moved him to the Welfare Home on Dunson Street, where he was visited by a number of people and some of them identified him as James Wilson Franklin and he admitted that was his name. Mrs. Hart spent a large sum of money trying to find his people, but all in vain. He died Sun. morning at 1 o'clock. Franklin's only brother lived in Montgomery, and he came Sunday and identified the man as his brother. Funeral services were held Monday afternoon at Fairmount Church in Red Level.
