This Indenture made and entered into this 23rd of Jan^y Eighteen hundred and thirty seven, Between Edmund Franklin of the State of Alabama, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of thirteen hundred and fifty dollars, the receipt of the same is hereby acknowledged, Edmund Franklin have bargained, sold, & released unto the said Sewell & Neely lands situated and lying in the County of Greene, Alabama, and bounded as follows, to wit: two $\frac{1}{8}$ laying in section 34, township 23, range 2 East, and to in section 27, township 23, range 2 E, the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$, One to in section 27, in township 23, range 2 E. being the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ consisting of two hundred and forty acres more or less, bounded by lands of Capt. W^m Price, Samuel Roberts P. To Have and to hold the lands hereby conveyed with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said C. Y. Neely his heirs and assigns forever, and I the said E. Franklin doth hereby covenant and agree that he will warrant and forever defend the aforesaid granted premises unto the said C. Y. Neely his heirs and assigns against the United States, and against my heirs and assigns forever. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal


