In the Name of God Amen this twenty day of January in the year of our Lord 1797 I James Rutherford of Edgefield County in the State of South Carolina being of Sound mind & Memory calling to mind the mortality of man, that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and Ordain This my last will & Testament & first of all it is my will that all my Just debts be punctually Paid — Item I give and Bequeath unto my loving Daughter Mary Perry living in Wake County N. Carolina five Shillings it being her full part of my Estate — Item I give & Bequeath unto my loving Daughter Elizabeth Perry living in Nash County N. Carolina five Shillings it being ^{her} my full part of my Estate Item I give & Bequeath unto my loving Sons Robt Rutherford & James Rutherford one Negro Girl named Effie it being their full parts of my Estate Item I give and Bequeath unto my loving Daughter Mary one Negro boy named Alice it being her full part

of my Estate I Give and Bequeath unto my loving Son Joseph Rutherford after the Death of my loving Wife my Negro woman Named Rachel and also my Negro boy Named Larmy with all her Increase forever with all my Stock of Horses Cattle Hogs Sheep &c. with all my household furniture to him and his heirs forever all which Estate given to Joseph Rutherford I lend to my beloved loving Wife Dussilla during her life To be paid by the above named Joseph Rutherford which be I do hereby appoint my Executor of this my last will and testament Revoking all other Wills - Signed sealed published pronounced & declared Delivered in presents of
