Here is the story related by the Foreman Funeral Home's Manager: Several weeks ago a man came to Andalusia and gave his name as Mr. GREEN. He was a sewing machine mechanic (he claimed), he was taken ill at Keys Boarding House and Mrs. Dell O'NEAL HART was called. She sent him to a local hospital were he stayed for several weeks. Mrs. HART later moved him to the Welfare Home on Dunson Street, where he was visited by a number of people and some of them identified him as James Wilson FRANKLIN and he admitted that was his name. Mrs. HART spent a large sum of money trying to find his people, but all in vain. He died Sun. morning at 1 o'clock. FRANKLIN's only brother lived in Montgomery, and he came Sunday and identified the man as his brother. Funeral services were held Monday afternoon at Fairmount Church in Red Level. Late Monday afternoon James Wilson FRANKLIN showed up in Andalusia. 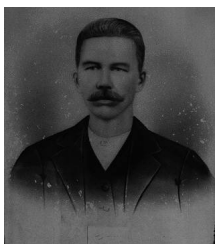
