Whereas Mary Tillman & others filed bill of complaint against John Tillman and Demarcus p.224 Tillman, on 28 January 1822 setting forth that Stephen Tillman lately died intestate seized of real estate to which afsd parties are entitled to distributive shares. Sale ordered. Commissioner Brooks after legally advertising, sold on 2 September 1822 at Edgefield Courthouse at public sale to Jesse Bettis for Fifteen hundred forty Dollars he being highest and last bidder. Four hundred thirty six acres on Horns Creek adj lands of estate of Stephen Tillman decd, Robert Reid, estate of Fedrick Tillman decd, estate of Sneed.
