To

Asa Jernigan, State of South Carolina
My Indenture made the fourteenth

day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred
and Ninety one and in the fifteenth year of the Independence of
the United States of North America Between Joseph Jernigan of
Edgefield and State of South Carolina yeoman of the said part, And
Asa Jernigan of the same place of the other party witnesseth
that the said Joseph Jernigan at and before the Sealing and Delivery
of these presents for and in consideration of the sum of six Shillings &
Sterling money to him in hands well and truly paid by the said
Asa Jernigan the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Both
the said Joseph Jernigan have bargained and sold and by these presents
do bargain and sell unto the said Asa Jernigan his heirs and
assigns forever All that Plantation or Tract of Land containing
seventy five acres more or less situate in the County aforesaid
on Rock bank Creek waters of Saluda River it being part of a
tract of land containing four hundred acres originally granted to
Thomas Deloach Sept by the Govr of Brtng Suth.
40 - the thirty first day of August anno domini 1774 and par
thereof conveyed to the said Joseph Jernigan by the said Thomas
Deloach by lease & release bearing date the seventh and eighth
days of March anno domini 1777 and the said twenty five acres
in Joseph Jernigan's part now conveyed to the said Asa Jernigan
and is divided from the remainder of said tract by Big Pine
on Rock bank Creek at the old Waggon road on a Sweet Gum
tree and running nearly N to a small Draw known by
me Marked pine tree and running up said Draw to Joseph
Jernigan line and running along said Joseph Jernigan line
to Joseph Thomas line and along Joseph Thomas line to Rock
Bank Creek White oak and along down said creek to the

beginning corner Together with all and Singular the Houses out
 Houses Edifices buildings barns orchards Woods underwood Timber
 and lumber being Meadowes pastures ponds Lakes fishing wayes water
 and Watercourses Paths passages Liberties Priviledges Hereditaments
 Rights Members and Appertaining thereto thenceunto belong
 ing or in any wise Appertaining and the Riverowm and River
 sions Bounding and Resounding Rents Taxes and Profits
 thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To Have and To Hold
 the Plantation or tract of Land containing Seventy five acres
 more or less unto the Said Asa Iernegaw his heirs Executors Ad-
 ministrators and Assignees from the day next before the day of the
 date of these presents for and During and unto the full end and
 Term of these presents and fully to be compleated and ended yel-
 ling and praying therefore unto the Said Iesse Iernegaw the Test
 of our present Com at the end of the Said Term if the same shall
 be lawfully Demanded to the intent and purpose that by virtue
 of these Presents and by some of the Statute for Transferring of
 us into possession he the Said Asa Iernegaw his heirs and Assignees
 may be in Actual possession and thereby be the better enabled to have
 take and Receive the Revenue and inheritances therof which is in-
 tended to be made and dated the day next after the day of the date
 hereof in Whitey Wheray I the P. Iesse Iernegaw have hereunto set my
 hand and Seal the day and year first above written Signed Sealed

 of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Ninety
 One and in the fiftieth year of the independence of the United States of
 America Between Iesse Iernegaw of Edgefield County and State of South
 Carolina Gentleman of the one part and Asa Iernegaw of the same
 Place of the other part Whereas in and by a certain Grant bearing
 date the thirty first day of August anno Dom 1774 under the hand
 of the Honble William Bull Esq^t late Gov^r Commander in Cheif
 in and over the Said State of South Carolina and Great Seal of the
 Province then called for that purpose Appointed did Give and
 Grant unto Thomas Deloach a plantation in had of Land —

Containing four hundred acres situate in the County Aforeaid on
 Red bank Creek waters of Little Sandy River and did Convey Two
 hundred acres thereof to Sise Ternegan by Deed and Release bearing
 date the Seventh - and Eighth day of March anno Dom 1777 &
 the Sise Ternegan ab and before the Sealing and Delivery of
 their Presents for and in consideration of the sum of ten pounds ster-
 ling Money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said
 Ternegan the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and
 be well contented satisfied and paid have Granted bargained and
 Alenched Remained Relained Conveyed and Confirmed and by these
 Presents doth Grant bargain Sell alien Remain Release Convey
 conform and by these presents unto the said Asa Ternegan his
 heirs and Assigns forever all that Plantation or tract of Land contain-
 ing Twenty five acres more or less being part of the aforesaid tract
 and lying on the E side of Red bank at the old Waggon ford and
 running nearly N along the Road to a small stream and running
 up the division betw. Sise Ternegans line and along said line to John
 Thomas line and along same to Red bank Creek and down thence
 to the place of Beginning Reference to the original plat and grant
 being had may more fully appear Together with all and singular
 the Houses out houses Edifices Buildings &c and all the appur-
 tenances whatsoever thereunto Belonging even any more upper
 Tanning the same being by virtue of a Law for a year given the
 day before the day of the date hereof and by force of the Statute for
 Transferring of us into possession and to his heirs and Assigns for
 ever all the Plantation or parcels of Land containing Twenty five acres
 more or less and the Reversion and Reverting Remainder and Re-
 mainders Rents Issues and profits thereof and all the estate right
 title interest and benefit possession profits benefits claims and de-
 mands whatsoever to alter change or determine the same and any
 part thereof To Have and To Hold the Plantation or tract of
 Land containing Twenty five acres as aforesaid and all Deeds
 evidences whatsoever Touching or concerning the same premises to
 the said Sise Ternegan doth hereby furtherly his heirs Establisht
 & Agrees covenant promise and Agree to and with the said Asa
 Ternegan his heirs and Assigns in Manner and form following
 that is to say he the said Sise Ternegan now is and until the
 Execution of these presents Shall stand Seized of a good sure
 perfect and undevissible Estate of inheritance in fee simple

of and in all the aforesaid plantation or tract of Land containing
 Seventy five acres more or less unto the said Asa Jernegan his heirs
 and assigns forever without any manner of debt trouble Mortgagor
 Condition trust Mortgage Judgment Execution or otherwise
 whatsoever to be alter changed or determine the same and also
 that he the said Asa Jernegan his heirs or assigns shall and
 may from time to time and at all times hereafter lawfully and
 lawfully have hold an occupy possess and enjoy the aforesaid land
 or tract of Land containing Seventy five acres to the only proper
 use and behoof of him the said Asa Jernegan his heirs and assigns
 forever and lastly the said Asa Jernegan doth hereby warrant
 and defend the aforesaid plantation or tract of Land containing
 Seventy five acres more or less unto the said Asa Jernegan his
 heirs and assigns forever against the Challenge Clause or Demand
 of all manner of person or persons whatsoever in respect therof
